Message from Mrs Lloyd

Thank you to everyone who ran in the Mini Marathon last weekend, it was lovely to see so many active families. There are some photos on the school website for you to see.



Dear Parents & Carers,
My daughter (Lily, Year 5) often asks me what I do when I visit the school and it struck me that she may not be the only one interested in that question. The autumn term is racing by so before anyone starts talking about 'sleeps till Santa' I thought I'd let you know what Jesse Gray's Governing Body have been up to recently.

We had our first full governing body meeting on 1 October and it was great to welcome two new parent governors to the group.....Louise Carey and Stefan Mars. We spent much of the meeting reviewing Ms Law's report from the summer term. As well as providing a great overview of what each year group has been doing, the summer term report also summarises a lot of data showing in detail how much progress key groups have made. It's quite heavy on the numbers, but a really important way for governors to help assess whether the school is delivering on the objectives in the School Improvement Plan. We also reviewed changes that were required to Jesse Gray's Child Protection Policy as a result of recent updates from the DfE.

As well as the full governing body, Jesse Gray also has a Resources Committee that oversees everything to do with the budget and finances at the school. The first Resources Committee meeting of the school year will be on 15 October. As well as the regular budget update that Louise Orange (the School Business Manager) will present, I'm really looking forward to discussing a proposal from a working party of staff and governors who have been looking at how Jesse Gray could make further use of technology to help transform teaching and learning at the school.

There's lots more going on for Jesse Gray's governors and I'd really love to get your views on what you'd like to hear about. Fran Moore has been helping us prepare a brief questionnaire so that you can have your say. Look out for it over the next few weeks and please do get in touch.
