Dear Parents and Carers,

We would like to invite you to the **Computing Curriculum and Digital Safety Evening 2019**, which is taking place on Thursday 21st March 2019 from 6pm to 7pm at Jesse Gray Primary School.

The purpose of the evening is to highlight the changes in Computing, which has developed to include Computer Science, Information Technology and Digital Literacy. We will be offering resources and ideas that can be used at home with the children from FS2 through to Year 6 as well as showcasing the future of Computing and the use of technology at Jesse Gray.

As part of our work surrounding Digital Literacy and online safety, we have been part of the 'Safer Schools' rollout of their new app for a range of devices. The app aims to enable parents and carers to understand in more detail, what children are accessing online so you can help make children safer at home. Details of how to download this app to your devices is included on the attached document. Our hope is that parents will feel more confident about how to encourage and develop their children's e-safety knowledge and skills, to becoming increasingly digitally literate.

The evening will also encompass how the Computing curriculum is taught throughout the school, from coding to using iPads and creating content. There will then be the opportunity to look over some of these resources with guides to help you use them at home. We will also be available to talk through the Safer Schools app in more detail.
