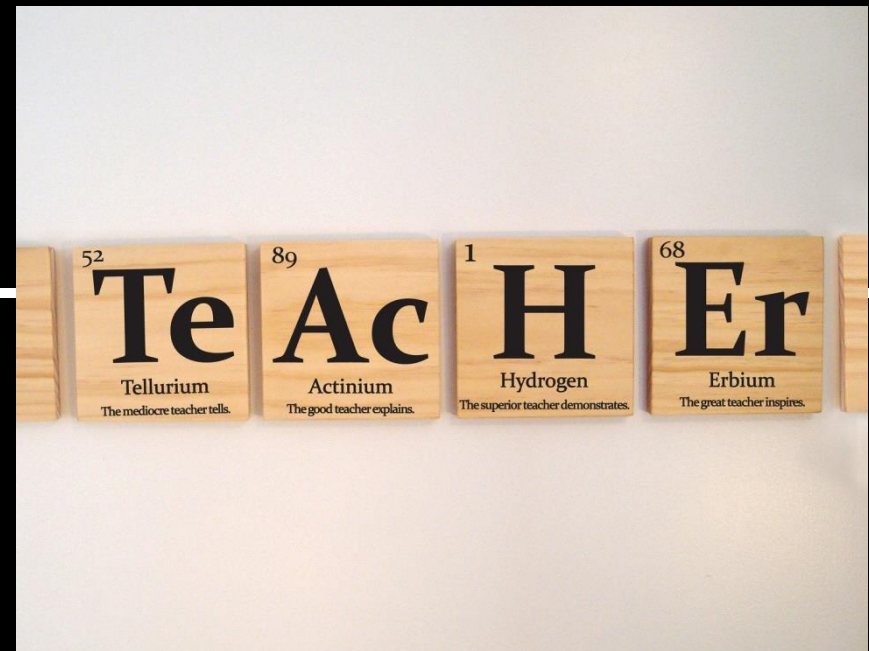

- **Reading Book~Daily**



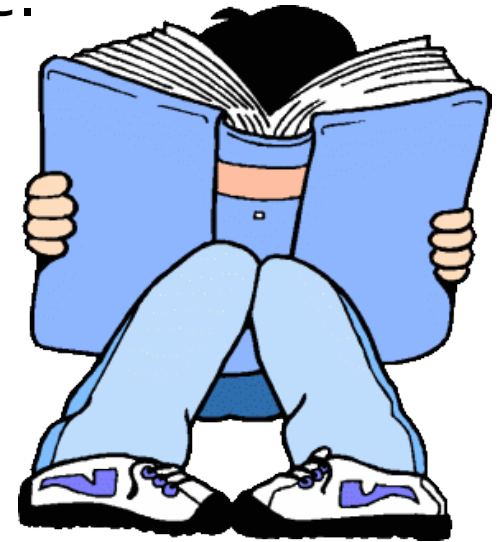
# Weekly Homework

- A mix of fiction/non-fiction if possible.
- Record in planner.
