Jesse Gray Primary School has a designated catchment area. Children living in our catchment area will have higher priority within the oversubscription criteria than children living outside the catchment area. There is no guarantee of a place for children residing within a catchment area or for children who subsequently move area at a later date.

Frequently Asked Questions

How many classes are there at Jesse Gray School?

We have 7 Year groups, 14 classes, 2 classes in each year group from Foundation to Year 6.

How many children are there at Jesse Gray School?

We currently have 425 children on roll (October 2020).

I live outside catchment, am I likely to get a place at Jesse Gray?

Jesse Gray Primary school has historically filled all spaces available with children within our catchment area. This does not mean you cannot apply.

My child has an Education Health Care Plan, what is the process for applying?

If your child has a Health and Care Plan (EHCP), different arrangements apply and you should contact the Integrated Children's Disability Service (0115 804 1275) for more information. Do you have a nursery?

No, Jesse Gray does not have a nursery.

Do you have an After School Club?

Yes Jesse Gray has a Breakfast Club and an After School Club for use by parents and carers of the school. Spaces are limited and we suggest that you apply early to avoid disappointment. Are hot dinners provided on site?

Yes, we have a school kitchen and all children in FS2, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a universal free school meal. We encourage all of the year groups to take up this entitlement.

What if I do not get a place at the school?

There is an appeals process managed by Nottinghamshire County Council.

What time is the school day?

The school day starts at 8.45am and finishes at 3.15pm, with a morning and afternoon break and a lunch break between 11.45am and 12.45pm.

Does my child have to wear a uniform?

Yes. The school colour is red and there is a simple uniform which children are encouraged to wear. We request that all children wear a minimum of one item of uniform with a school logo each day. School uniform with a logo can be purchased
