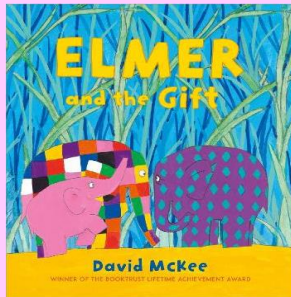

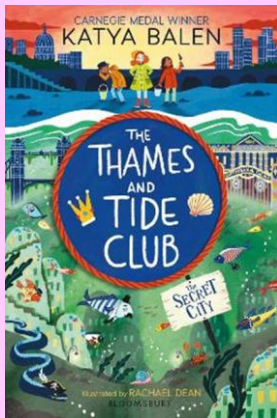
KS1 Elmer and the Gift by David McKee
