As you are probably already aware, the end of year 6 trip will be a trip to Spring Lakes in Long Eaton. It will take place on Monday 24th July. The trip will be **£19.50**; this is due to the fantastic amount of money raised in the Y6 fair and also a donation from the JGA. Without the fundraising by the children it would have cost **£35.60** per child!

Date: Monday 24th July 2023

Departing: 8.30am (please arrive at school at 8.15am for registration)

Returning: 4pm

Cost: A contribution of £19.50 to be paid by **16th June 2023**

Payments can be made via Parent Pay online up to 16th June. If you need any assistance with Parent Pay please speak to the school office. (If you do not wish to contribute, please email the school office to provide consent for your child to attend). The office will send out reminder emails/texts up to this point, but if you haven't paid/consented or contacted school to let them know your child will be unable to go on this trip, we will not be chasing parents individually asking for consent after this date. Due to the logistics and costs of this trip, if sufficient payments and consent is not given the trip may not be able to go ahead.

Spring Lakes request that all participants have completed a waiver from their parent or guardian to attend. This is managed electronically. Please wear a swimming costume when taking part in water activities. If it is a sunny day and you do not plan on wearing a wetsuit, then we suggest you wear a light t-shirt to cover your shoulders and if you are going on a SUP or pedalo then we also strongly suggest a hat is worn. We also recommend you wear suncream to protect yourself from the sun.

We do suggest you wear water shoes or sandals when going on our beach. There are fresh water mussels within the water and these can be sharp if stood on.
