FS2- Trip to White Post Farm 04/07/2023

Dear Parents and Carers,

To celebrate the children's first year at Jesse Gray, we are planning to take the Foundation Stage children to White Post Farm on Tuesday 4th July.

As part of the visit the children will enjoy a guided walk around the farm, seeing all the animals and have the opportunity to feed some of them. We will also have a tractor ride and a visit to the play area. Lunch will be a picnic, hopefully outdoors in the sunshine or in the barn, followed by a Bird of Prey display.

Date: Tuesday 4th July 2023
Departing: 9am
Returning: 3.15pm approximately
Cost: A voluntary contribution of £18.75 to be paid by 30th June 2023

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £18.75 to cover the cost of the trip to White post farm (includes coach fare, entrance fee, guided walks, Bird of Prey display and tractor ride.) Payment can be made via Parent Pay online. If you need any assistance with setting up a Parent Pay account, please speak to the school office. (If you do not wish to contribute, please email the school office to provide consent for your child to attend). The office will send out reminder emails/texts up to this point, but if you haven't paid/consented or contacted school to let them know your child will be unable to go on this trip, we will not be chasing parents individually asking for consent after this date.

What to wear: Your child will need to wear school uniform, sensible shoes for lots of walking and we will be taking their Jesse Gray hats. They will also need sun cream applying before school, a lightweight waterproof coat, as the majority of the day is outdoors, and we will be outside - even if it is raining.

What to bring: School will provide a packed lunch for each child. This will consist of a sandwich, a piece of fruit, a yoghurt and cake. We will take water bottles and our own snacks.

We would appreciate some parent helpers on the day. If you are available to help then please contact the class teachers or the school office.
